- Attendance at weekly staff inservice meetings and training during Summer 2011.

**Weekly Meeting During Semesters: Friday, from 2 – 3:30**

- Able to perform student intern job duties and be accountable by adhering to Student Health and Counseling Services policies and procedures and Program Manager(s) supervision.
- Internships may be taken for 1-3 units per semester. Each unit equals approximately 3 hours per week. Units may be earned through Interdisciplinary (ID) 195A and B or through an academic department arranged by you. (Must be eligible for upper division units)
