Cultivating Scientist and Engineer Educators

The Professional Development Program (PDP) is the centerpiece of a suite of education programs developed through the Center for Adaptive Optics, which is headquartered at UC Santa Cruz. The PDP recruits early-career scientists and engineers (mostly graduate students) and trains them to develop and teach inquiry activities. In the process, participants develop new knowledge about diversity and equity studies and strategies, and knowledge about effective education practices and education research. They also reflect on their own inquiry, or research, skills, and they emerge as leaders who integrate research and education in their professional practice. Dr. Metevier will describe the PDP, including her contributions to the program as one of a core team of staff educators.
