Email Fraud

The University Police Department wishes to alert the campus about unsolicited e-mails claiming to be from Huntington Bank. Both faculty and staff members have received these e-mails.

The e-mails, sent in different formats, often include "Security Update Notification" or "Personal Security Alert" in the e-mail subject heading. The e-mails ask that you verify your internet banking account by clicking on a link and entering your user ID and password.

If you receive this type of unsolicited e-mail asking for personal or bank information, consider it fraudulent and do not respond to it.

If you have lost money as result of this type of crime, please report it to the University Police at (916) 278-6851, or e-mail us at police@csus.edu. The University Police will investigate or forward to the appropriate investigative agency.
