A threatening e-mail has been received by a member of the campus community. The email demands money in return for not harming the recipient. The email appears to be part of a scam that is being circulated on the internet.

If you have received this or any type of threatening email on your Sac State email account, please contact our department immediately. If you receive threatening email on any other email account, please contact the appropriate law enforcement agency in your jurisdiction. Another option is to initiate a report at the Internet Crime Complaint Center at www.ic3.gov. This website is sponsored by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the National White Collar Crime Center (NW3C).
