Between Thursday April 9 and Monday April 13, there have been four backpacks reported stolen. Three were stolen from the Library and one was stolen from the University Union, all four backpacks were left unattended. Three of the backpacks have been recovered. One was recovered from the Men's Restroom in the Library intact and the other two were recovered from Parking Structure # 3 near the elevators/stairwell with property missing.

The subject suspected in two of the cases was described as a male white adult, about six foot one inches tall, with blond or light brown hair. He wore a gray hooded sweatshirt, and dark jeans. In the University Union case he was also wearing a red and white baseball cap, a dark colored jacket with white stripes on the sleeves, and dark shoes. See photo below.
