- Maintain round-the-clock police presence
- Protect infrastructure and property
 - Monitor buildings for damage or potential damage
 - Anticipate and prepare for potential risks (fire, shootings, bombs, etc.)
 - Maintain police presence as deterrent to crime
- Expanded Patrol of campus buildings based on analysis
 - Apply additional resources to specific areas to minimize risk
- Preserve campus safety
 - Protect life
 - Respond to and stabilize incidents
 - Protect campus (and personal) property
 - > Loss prevention saves money (i.e., prevention of graffiti saves clean-up costs)
 - Disaster response (constant readiness)
 - Analyze threats
 - > Identify potential scenarios and prepare (and train) for managing or prevention
 - Maintain police presence on campus
 - > Creating a Safe Academic Environment
 - > Deters crime
 - Provide round-the-clock emergency and non-emergency customer service for the university community
 - > 24-hour availability
 - > Fully operational 911 service provider for the university community.
- Protect officials and dignitaries on campus
 - > Event and Pre-Event Analysis
- Provide service for special events
 - Officers support official university events such as the U.S. Olympic Trials, NCAA Track & Field Finals etc...
 - Officers assigned to cover non-official campus events like weddings, etc
 - > Service costs reimbursed by customers; no cost to taxpayers.
