- Support and strengthen the projects underway (FYE SacReads, One Book, English Pilot) and gather data to inform programmatic and research initiatives
- "Seed" GE Pilot's using Campus Goals, Outcomes and Objectives as a framework building on best practices within the state, in the Compass Network, and nationally
- Gather data about student/faculty perspectives on student learning in GE and frequency, distribution and participation in high impact practices
