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JUSTIFICATION:

We are seeking to cross-list ENGL 225C with EDTE 225C, an identical course offered by the Department of Teacher Education. Both courses are part of the Certificate in Teaching Reading to Adults, which is a collaborative program between the two departments. The departments will offer the course alternately. When faculty in English teach the course, it will be offered as ENGL 225C; when faculty in Teacher Education teach the course, it will be offered as EDTE 225C. Students in the Certificate in Teaching Reading to Adults program will take either EDTE 225C or ENGL 225C, but not both.



