JUSTIFICATION:

In reviewing our program, we saw a need for a broader emphasis on research and assessment in child development. We also feel the course as currently taught includes too much material for students to digest in a single 3-unit course. We are thus creating an additional course for observation and assessment in child development, which will include some of the material currently covered in CHDV 133, specifically much of the qualitative and descriptive research and some instruction on APA Style. We are thus limiting the scope of the CHDV 133 course, and requiring that they not enroll in both methods courses simultaneously.

Understanding readings of selected topics in human development research. Content will include the consideration of the framework and methodology of quantitative research. Emphasis will be on increasing students' ability to locate, understand, critique and report research findings. Discussion and participation in such classroom activities as small group presentations and cooperative learning assignments.



