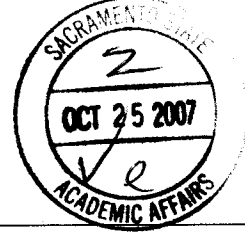

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JUSTIFICATION:

This proposal seeks to change the course description and prerequisite requirements in the University Catalog for EDC 480: Field Study in Counseling. The description has been updated to more clearly and accurately reflect the nature of the students' field study experience. Also, the Department wants to make the requirements of EDC 480 available to applicants and/or students in advance so they can prepare for the serious time commitment involved in this important clinical and professional development experience.

Supervised counseling and field experiences arranged in community-based settings such schools, colleges and/or agencies. One hundred clock hours of experience required for each unit of credit for a total of 600 clock hours (or 6 units). Weekly supervision is provided throughout the field experience: 1 hour per week of individual/triadic supervision and 1½ hours per week of group supervision.



