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**JUSTIFICATION:**

This is a name change for an elective course in the Commercial Recreation, Tourism and Hospitality emphasis area of our degree program. The course has always focused on elements of the hospitality industry other than resorts, including hotels, ski lodges, casinos and cruise lines. Including the word "hospitality" in the title is a more accurate description of the course. There is a minor correction to the course description (the change of one word).



