**Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification.**

3+ years of experience with our SB 2042 Program indicates that students need more course-related fieldwork experience in our Multiple Subject Credential Program. Thus, units are being shifted from student teaching to two courses to provide more fieldwork experiences related to specific course content. In addition, a new course has been developed to provide students with instructional support as they complete the new state requirement for a Teaching Performance Assessment. This course is patterned after an already existing course in our Single Subject Credential Program that has proven to be very successful.
