JUSTIFICATION:

The proposed name change better reflects the subject-matter and methods engaged during the course. This is not a "survey course" of peoples, regions, or cultures, but an exploration of Europe as a social and political construct – a field of study that is burgeoning among anthropologists in the years since the EU became a sociopolitical reality and the question of forming specifically European identities became paramount. Moreover, this course is strictly ethnographic in its approach, and doesn't draw on methods or theories from other subfields of anthropology such as archaeology or biological anthropology. Nothing else about the course will be changed but its name.



