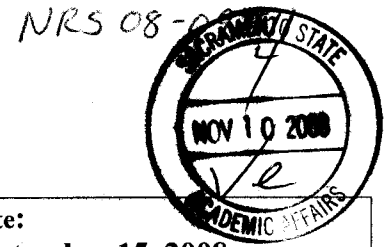

JUSTIFICATION:

The LVN 30-unit option required by Section 1435.5 in the Laws Relating to Nursing Education Licensure – Practice in the State of California limits the program to a total of 30 units. To accomplish this as set forth in the accompanying Form B, the leadership and management content required by the California Board of Registered Nursing will be met with the course proposal for N113 Leadership & Management for the LVN 30-Unit Option. The Board of Registered Nursing mandates that the leadership and management content be specific to nursing role development. The content within this course assumes that the LVN has had exposure to a portion of the content in previous coursework and work experiences and therefore the content requirement can reasonably be met in a two unit course while fulfilling the mandated limit of 30 units for the program.

NURS 113 Leadership & Management for the LVN 30-Unit Option: This course is designed to present leadership and management skills for the Licensed Vocational Nurse transitioning to the Registered Nurse role. The principles and processes of administration, management, and supervision will be discussed within an organizational framework. Lecture two hours.
Prerequisites: Microbiology with a lab (4), Physiology with a lab (4), NURS 123 Nursing the Family in Complex Illness, NURS 119 Mental Health Nursing for the LVN 30-Unit Option
Corequisites: NURS 137 Nursing the Childbearing Family, NURS 138 Nursing the Childrearing Family
