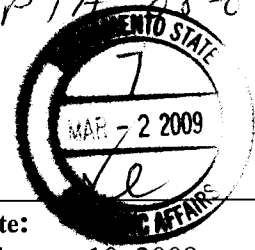

JUSTIFICATION:

Anthropology and Recreation, Parks and Tourism Administration have cross-listed this course in the past (ANTH 187/RPTA 187). There was also a 50/50 split on seats assigned to each department. Traditionally very few RPTA majors took the course, and because of the low enrollment, it was not offered frequently. Anthropology has modified their program, and the course has now been given a prerequisite of ANTH 146, which will most likely result in even fewer RPTA majors taking the course. In addition, the course title will be changed to ANTH 187: Cultural Representation and Commodification. Rather than continue to cross-list the course and require RPTA majors to take ANTH 146, RPTA would like to de-cross-list the course, which will be beneficial to both departments.



