Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification. <p>The graduate program in nursing was reviewed to assure inclusion of the Essentials for Graduate Education in Nursing as adopted by the American Association of Colleges of Nursing and the accrediting body, the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education. In this review, some redundancies in the curriculum were discovered. The changes in the core for the graduate program serve a variety of purposes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Eliminate all 2 unit courses that increase program costs for students. 2. Eliminate redundancy in the curriculum. 3. Assure inclusion of the Essentials for Graduate Programs in Nursing. 4. Reduce overall units required for completion of the Graduate Program in Nursing. 5. Update course content to include content Germaine to the profession of Nursing at the graduate level and eliminate content not relevant to the advanced practice of Nursing. 6. Alignment of the curriculum with the outcome measure of the comprehensive examination for the culminating experience.
