Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification.

The proposed program seeks to modify undergraduate co-requisite requirements for the M.S. in Counseling program. Existing co-requisite requirements include: PSYC 168: Abnormal Psychology (or equivalent), EDC 170: Introduction to Counseling, and EDC 171: Power Privilege and Self-Identity in Counseling. Specifically, this proposal seeks to "add" a new course, EDC 172: Child and Family Psychopathology, as an option for students to take instead of PSYC 168. Thus, students will have a "choice" between PSYC 168 and EDC 172. The purpose for offering this new course is to provide those students who will specialize in working with children an opportunity to study in greater depth the area of abnormal development in children and family systems.
