The proposed program changes, specifically the eventual deletion of PSYC 1 and PSYC 5 and their replacement with a single introductory psychology course PSYC 2 may affect the GE program but is expected to have little impact. Analysis of Institutional Research data for the current semester shows that only 28 students enrolled in PSYC 1 and PSYC 5 concurrently. In addition, we plan on offering a distance education section of the PSYC 2 course which should accommodate the GE demand.
