Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification. The changes were necessary in order that the Master Degree courses were similar with those required in the Preliminary Administrative Services Credential program. All Advanced Seminar electives were eliminated from the new proposed program. The new program kept several of the existing courses (EDLP 202, 203, 250, 255, 296 and 299). We provide two options for students in the Culminating Experience Section. In option one, students can take EDLP 230 and 500A. In Option two, students take EDLP 500A and 500B. Several courses were modified and new ones created 200 (200B), 201 (201B), 204 (204B), 205, (205B) and 209 (209B). The total number of units remained at 30. The revised course descriptions are included in FORMS A.
