Bylaws of the Academic Senate, California State University, Sacramento, Article III.B:

"1. ... At the meeting to nominate, the order of business shall be (1) nomination of candidates for the office of Chair,

(2) nomination of candidates for the office of Vice Chair, (3) nomination of candidates for the five elected members of the Executive Committee. Nominations of candidates for Chair and Vice Chair shall be made from the floor; nomination of oneself shall be permitted. If more than two nominations either to the office of Chair or the office of Vice Chair are made, the Senate shall immediately select from among the several nominees to the office, the two whose names shall be put to a vote in the subsequent election. The selection shall be made by secret Each Senator shall have one vote in relation to each ballot. Each of the two candidates selected shall receive more votes than any candidate not selected. When the Senate has finished nominating candidates for Chair and Vice Chair, it shall nominate candidates for the five elected members of the Executive Committee. Nominations shall be made from the floor; nomination of oneself shall be permitted. Additional nominations to the Executive Committee may be made at the meeting to elect the officers of the Senate."
