FS 12/13-159/FL RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR ROBERT BUCKLEY UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE FACULTY OF CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SACRAMENTO

WHEREAS: Robert Buckley, when speaking before the Faculty Senate, would regularly

preface his remarks by saying, "you need to know the context..." and, "I'll be

brief"; and

WHEREAS: Occasionally, he actually was; and

WHEREAS: Robert Buckley has, for more than fifteen years, been a force for shared

governance on the Sacramento State campus, serving an unprecedented five

terms as Faculty Senate chair; and

WHEREAS: Robert Buckley has been one of the campus's strongest and most articulate

advocates for faculty consultation and involvement at all levels in the decisionmaking process on questions affecting curriculum and the use of academic

resources;

WHEREAS: He has served on campus committees and working groups too numerous to

mention, including four years as Academic Policy Committee chair, and as a member of every committee or task force dealing with academic technology

that ever existed anywhere; and

WHEREAS: Robert Buckley has for eight years, showed the same commitment to higher

education and shared governance on the CSU system-wide level, through his eight years of service, frequently in leadership positions, on the CSU Academic

Senate; and

WHEREAS: None of this even begins to acknowledge his ongoing commitment to the

students in his classroom, whether it be in the supervision of senior research

projects or the conduct of freshman seminars; be it therefore

RESOLVED: That this summary of Robert Buckley's contributions be considered "brief" in

the same spirit as, in the past, his own remarks to the Faculty Senate used to be

considered brief"; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Faculty Senate of the California State University wish Bob Buckley,

his golf clubs, and his hot, shiny new Miata nothing but success in all future

endeavors.
