The University ARTP Committee recommends amendment of the subject section by inserting after item 3 the following phrase and renumbering the subsequent items:

4. Evidence of creativity in the development or application of technology or both in ways that contribute to the advancement of teaching, research or performance.

This amendment is recommended by way of endorsing and giving expression to the initiative taken by Professor Manny Gale, Social Work, to recognize for RTP purposes the creativity of faculty who develop or apply technology in ways that advance teaching, research and performance. By this language, the Committee intends to be understood as requiring some demonstration of inventiveness to qualify an activity under this item within the category of "scholarly or creative activity". In the opinion of the Committee, mere use, however much labor may be required to accomplish it, is not enough to make the activity "creative".

The Committee requests that its Chair be invited to participate in the Executive Committee's discussion of this recommendation.
