**NOTES:**

Approval of the Summer 2004 schedule is needed prior to the October 1, 2003 call for summer 2004 schedules.

The proposed calendar is identical in structure and length to the summer 2003 calendar.

“This is the most likely calendar for Summer 04 given when the Spring semester is over (May 26, 2004 (W)) and when the Fall 04 semester is likely to begin (August 25, 2004 (W)).

CSU policy requires that there be no overlap between the end of the Spring semester and the start of the Fall semester. The Fall 04 semester will be the same whether we go with the modified trimester calendar or stick with a traditional calendar, because we have to start the Fall semester in time to finish before the holiday break. Starting Fall instruction on August 30 (the recommended date in the modified trimester proposal) would result in commencement on Dec 17 and 18.”
