To find an advisor, go to your major department. Taking this important step may help you avoid being academically disqualified from Sacramento State. In addition, your major department may place a HOLD in your record, preventing you from registering until you see an advisor in your major.

1.	Are you working too many hours and taking too many units? A good formula to use is 2 hours of study time for each hour in class, or 9 hours per week for each 3 unit class. On average, successful students follow these guidelines: Taking 15 units but Limit work to 15 hours per week Taking 12 units but Limit work to 24 hours per week Taking 9 units but Limit work to 30 hours per week Taking 6 units but Limit work to 40 hours per week Enter the number of units you are currently taking: Enter the average number of hours you are working per week:
