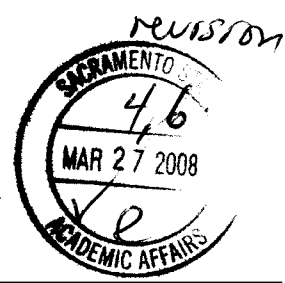

Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification. The Asian Studies Major is an inter-disciplinary major that was created by a number of faculty from different departments in the late 1980s. Since that time a number of faculty teaching Asia related courses have retired and a new group of faculty with expertise on Asia have been hired. Though there is some overlap between what the founding faculty offered and what the new faculty teach, there are a number of courses from the original major no longer offered as regularly as they once were and there are many new courses that have been developed by the new faculty which need to be incorporated into the major. The major revisions being proposed also take into account the recommendations of the last program review, most notably the addition of a senior capstone course.

Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification. CHANGE: The Teaching Credential Program: Multiple Subject will be dropping one course (EDS 216) requirement. This action is in response to community feedback, student surveys, and as a reaction to mandated CCTC Standards for the Mild/Moderate Educational Specialist Credential. Additionally, in response to the above constituents and standards, the lecture/lab paradigm is being applied to several methodology classes (EDS 101A/B, 273A/B, 276A/B & 292A/B). The format of these courses will have a theoretical framework (A) and a field based/lab application (B). Finally, in response to the above constituents, an existing options class (EDS 276A/B) will become part of the required coursework for the Mild/Moderate Educational Specialist Credential and one unit will be added to the initial EDS 232 seminar.
