Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification.

Section 1435.5 in the Laws Relating to Nursing Education Licensure – Practice in the State of California provides an opportunity for the Licensed Vocational Nurse to prepare for licensure as a Registered Nurse by completing no more than 30 units of designated courses. The LVN 30-Unit Option Program is a non-degree program designed for individuals who currently hold a valid California LVN license. The 30-Unit Option students are admitted on a space available basis. Selection from qualified applicants is based on cumulative GPA for the 30 most recent graded semester units as well as the combined GPA of the pre-requisite courses.

The Division of Nursing previously requested a change in the requirements for the LVN 30-Unit Option Program. The program that was approved was subsequently denied approval by the Board of Registered Nursing. We are requesting the current changes that reflect the approved course of study by the Board of Registered Nursing.

After a needs assessment was completed with students that attempted the current program, it was found that not only was there a challenge with content, but the content in the proposed program would be more aligned with the administration role in nursing. After evaluating the needs and academic levels of the students, the proposed program supports the nursing curricula and meets the educational needs in leadership and management preparation. The College of Business concurs and supports this change in the program.</p>
