Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification.						
We are proposing this new program for the Preliminary Mod/Severe and Multiple Subject Credential for two reasons. The first reason is that our Mod/Severe Specialist Credential Program has been changed (see <i>Mod/Sev_FormB_Proposal.docx</i>). The second reason is that we are bringing the Multiple Subject Credential portion in sync with the Mild/Mod & Multiple Subject Credential.						
The Moderate/Severe and Multiple Subject Credential Pathway will include the revised Moderate/Severe course requirements while maintaining the currently approved structure for the Multiple Subject course requirements. Also, as recommended by the past-Chair of EDTE and supported by the current Chair, the "Identifier" of the following new courses are proposed to be EDS 332 and EDS 420B to better reflect the department that houses the students and is responsible for the staffing of these experiences. The new final multiple subject student teaching course also reduces the units from 10 down to five-units.
