Items discussed during open forum included the following:

Department/Division Chair Policy

Helen Lee reported that the English Dept. is agreeable with the policy as proposed. The change of ½ vote for Temporary Faculty up to 7.5 WTUs was acceptable to Temp. Faculty in English. Gerri Smith indicated the proposed change was acceptable in Comm. Studies. Each dept. and Sociology (Todd Migliaccio) will affirm acceptance when presented to the Senate. A list of FAQs was drafted and posted to GoogleDocs for commenting. Policy is ready to present to Exec.

Academic Leaves With Pay Policy

Adam Rechs advised he was working on a draft with the proposed language incorporated. One issue raised was why CCE should have a representative on the committee – do they have faculty who can apply for sabbaticals? Another question was about the substitution of "at most" vs. "at least" currently in the policy, with the possible impact during lean financial times. Further discussion will take place next meeting.

As our guest is a member of APC, who has been examining the On-line Student Evaluation of Teaching process, we discussed the next step in the role of the two committees, FPC and APC. Generally, a faculty survey sounded like a good idea to examine what problems and/or concerns

faculty had with the process as it stands. Reports from ATCS seem to indicate the process is working, but anecdotal evidence from faculty suggests areas of concern. Potential questions for the survey can be compiled by the chair and the idea of a future survey can be pursued as a joint APC/FPC endeavor.
