Your California Nonresident Tuition Waiver (AB540) has been approved. You do not need to send any other information for this waiver. You will receive no other notification regarding this waiver.

Please note the following:

1. The waiver does not change your residency status. You will continue to be classified as a non-resident of California. However, when you register for classes and are billed for tuition fees, you will only be charged the resident tuition rate.
2. If you have applied for financial aid through the Dream Act, the Financial Aid Office will be notified of your waiver approval. Any questions regarding the processing of your financial aid must be addressed to the Financial Aid Office. The Admissions Office is not able to tell you the status of your Dream Act application.
3. If you have a residency verification checklist item on the to-do list in your [My Sac State Student Center](#), this will be removed by Financial Aid within 4-6 weeks. Please do not contact the Admissions Office in regard to this checklist item.
4. Other to-do list items pertaining to residency may take up to a semester to be removed. If you are receiving this email, you do not need to submit any more information.
