Make Movies

WHAT

Pinnacle Studio is a video editing and DVD authoring software application for use on a PC to create digital movies with video clips, audio, images, text and a variety of effects.

Use it to transfer, edit, and publish video from a VHS tape or a Camcorder to your computer or other storage media such as a CD or DVD. The process to make your movies is easy. To get started follow the three steps: capture, edit and make movie.

WHY

Create movies and presentations for your class that will help your students understand course material and to motivate class and group discussions. Use it to enhance your courses and meet the different learning needs and styles of your students.

WHEN

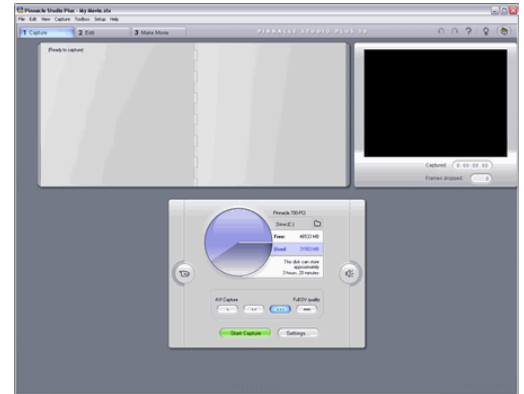
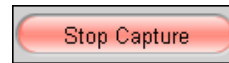
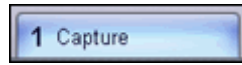
- Combine various video clips from different movies with text and transitions related to topics covered in class.
- Use recorded student presentations and/or speeches to make a movie(s) to show as examples to future students
- Record a specific procedure for students to follow.
 - how perform a scientific experiment
 - how to pronounce words in another language
 - how to perform a medical procedure
- How do you see using movies to enhance your course?

HOW

To get you started creating a movie follow these steps:

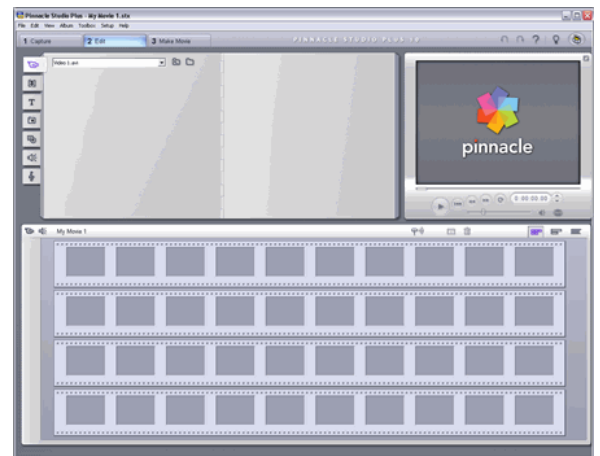
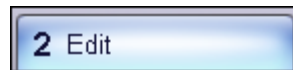
Capture the Video

- step 1.* Select the Capture Tab
- step 2.* Click on the Start Capture Button
- step 3.* Provide a name for your clip
- step 4.* Click the Stop Capture Button to stop transfer process
- step 5.* Repeat this process to import all video clips



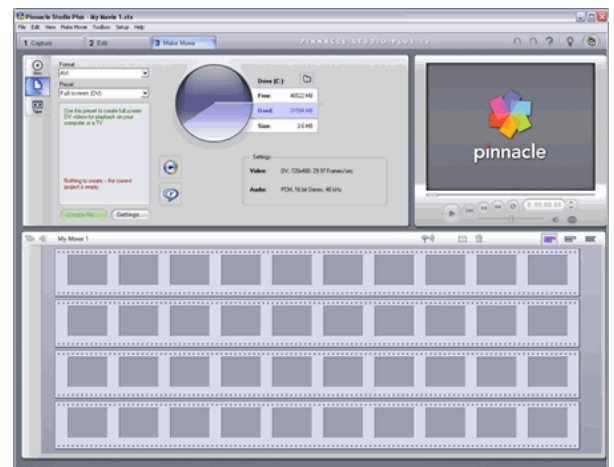
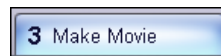
Edit Your Movie

- step 1.* Select the Edit Tab
- step 2.* Click the Video Scenes tab from the group of tabs on the left side of the screen.
- step 3.* Locate your video clips if they are not displayed. To locate them, click the folder icon to the right of the name of the current video file.
- step 4.* Verify that you are in Storyboard or Timeline view by clicking either the Storyboard or Timeline view button.
- step 5.* Click and drag each video clip from the scenes pane to the storyboard or timeline.



Make the Movie

- step 1.* Select the Make Movie Tab
- step 2.* Click the Stream tab
- step 3.* Click the RealVideo radio button
- step 4.* Click the Settings button to enter video settings
- step 5.* Click the Create Web file button and name the file
- step 6.* Click OK
