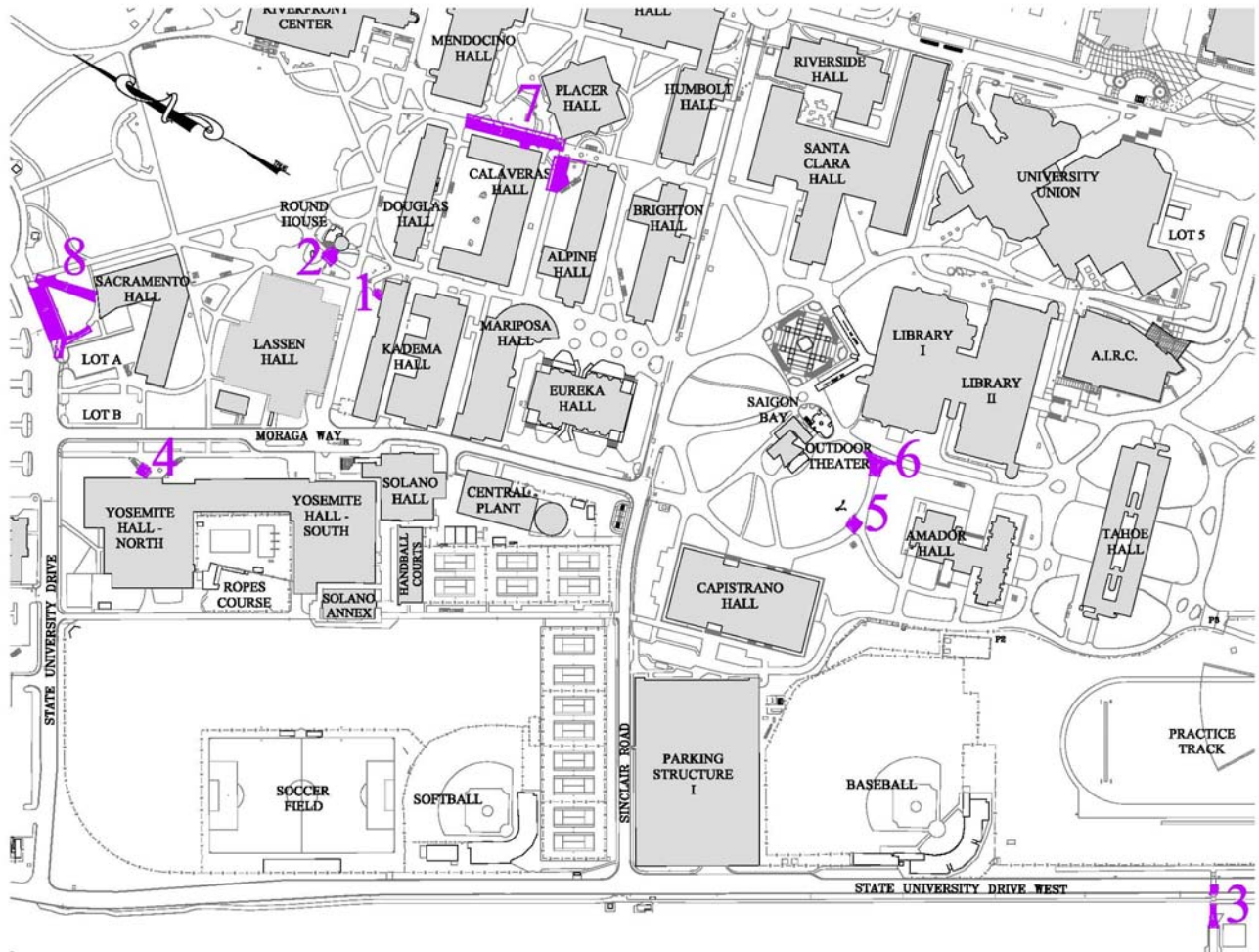

**Site #1:** Excavate and pave entry to Witt Gallery in front of Kadema Hall. This work will begin Monday (7/27) morning and be completed by Wednesday (7/29) afternoon.

**Site #2:** Excavate and pave the walkway between Lassen Hall and Roundhouse. The walkway will be closed for three days as work will begin Monday (7/27) morning and be completed by Wednesday (7/29) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize the walkway on the East side of the Roundhouse for entry and exit.

**Site #3:** Pave the walkway at the Hornet Crossing on July 27<sup>th</sup>. The walkway will be closed for one day.

**Site #4:** Excavate and pave the walkway on the East entrance to Yosemite Hall North Gym. The walkway will be closed for two days as work will begin Tuesday (7/28) morning and be completed by Wednesday (7/29) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize the entrance on the East side of the South Gym for entry and exit.

**Site #5:** Excavate and pave the walkway between Amador Hall and the Outdoor Theater. The walkway will be closed for two days as work will begin Tuesday (7/28) morning and be completed by Wednesday (7/29) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize alternate pathways around this area.

**Site #6:** Excavate and pave the walkway between Amador Hall and the Library. The walkway will be closed for three days as work will begin Wednesday (7/29) morning and be completed by Friday (7/31) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize alternate pathways around this area.

**Site #7:** Excavate and pave the walkway between Calaveras Hall and Placer Hall. The walkway will be closed for five days as work will begin Thursday (7/30) morning and be completed by Monday (8/3) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize alternate pathways around this area.

**Site #8:** Excavate and pave the walkway and parking lot on the North side of Sacramento Hall. The walkway will be closed for five days as work will begin Monday (8/3) morning and be completed by Thursday (8/6) afternoon. Pedestrians will need to utilize alternate pathways around this area. 9 new standard parking stalls will replace the existing 3 parallel parking spaces as approved by UTAPS.

Each of these 8 sites requires concrete and asphalt work, necessitating 3 days in each area to achieve cure times on the newly installed materials. If you have any questions regarding this project scope and/or schedule, please contact Todd McComb at extension 8-5183.
