## Guidelines

In the age of budget cuts, deficits and spending caps, every little bit counts, and \$1,000 could go a long way toward improving your school. How would you use the money? New uniforms for the soccer team? Fresh paint in the hallways? New supplies for art class? Instruments for the band? Costumes for the school play? Break out your video camera and create a 60-second Public Service Announcement (PSA) showing what \$1,000 would do for your school.

1. A registration form (with your principal's signature) must be submitted with each entry.\*
2. PSA entries must be submitted by mail in DVD format. The postmark deadline is **Friday, October 16, 2009**.
3. All PSA entries must have the approval of the school principal in order to be considered as an official entry.

## Prizes

One video from the *individual category* and one video from the *class/club category* will be selected as official prize-winning entries and prize money will be awarded directly to your school for the project highlighted in the winning video.

## Eligibility

California high school students of all grades are eligible to participate in either the *class/club* or *individual category*. Students may only enter in one category.
