What is the “N194 Cooperative Education Orientation”??

This orientation is the first step in the process of gaining a paid student nurse intern position for credit in the N194 course – your opportunity to practice advanced nursing skills prior to graduation! Students who are interested in participating in this program for the first time in the Spring of 2010 **MUST** attend (students currently placed during Fall 2009 need not attend to continue their Co-op experience) The orientation introduces students to the recruiters, the process, and the paperwork. A resume and cover letter workshop will also be provided.

Who is eligible??

- Students in the Clinical BSN program at Sac State, graduating no earlier than May 2010.
- Students who have completed or who are currently in their Advanced Medical Surgical Clinical Rotation.
- Students who are NOT planning to take any electives in the Spring of 2010.
- Students with at least a 3.5 GPA in nursing classes who have not been in clinical or theory jeopardy in the Spring 2009 and Fall 2009 semesters.
