Patient Care Intern

Patient Care Internships with the UCD Hospice Program are unpaid and require a commitment of at least 4 hours a week for 6 months. In this role interns will receive 24 hours of training on concepts of death and dying, care and comfort measures, psychological issues, spiritual and cultural issues, grief and bereavement, and the role of volunteers in hospice. Patient Care interns provide in-home companionship, caregiver relief, and other support services to hospice patients. Interns are supervised on a regular basis by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker to improve their patient care skills. For more information on requirements, deadlines, and how to apply, please see
