Frequently Asked Questions - Freshmen

I was just admitted to CSUS for next semester. What should I do now?

First of all, be sure to sign up to attend a New Student Orientation Session! At Orientation you will have the opportunity to learn about important university resources, as well as receive information about the Business Pre-Major from Academic Counselors who work specifically with Business students.

Who can answer my questions about General Education courses?

The Academic Advising Center in Lassen Hall has Counselors that can provide unofficial G.E. advising.

How can I schedule an appointment with a Business Counselor?

Check the Degree Programs Center Website for the best time to call for an appointment (usually the last Monday of each month for appointments for the following month). Call early, as our appointment schedule fills up quickly!

What if I just have a quick question about the Business major? Can I speak with a Business Counselor without an appointment?

What if I need to drop a course?

Pick up a Drop Petition from the DPC; follow the instructions on the back of the form (note key dates for dropping classes). If you need to completely withdraw from the university for the semester, contact the Academic Advising Center in Lassen Hall.

What if I need a tutor? Who do I contact?

For Business courses, stop by the Business Tutoring & Study Center, 3067 Tahoe Hall.
