Bachelor of Science, Business Administration **Transferable Lower Division Prerequisites**

All students admitted to the College of Business Administration at CSUS are admitted as Pre-Majors. Students must complete all lower division prerequisites before enrolling in upper division business courses at CSUS. When enrolled in the last of the lower division prerequisites, students must submit a Change of Status petition and unofficial transcripts to the Degree Programs Center

(1030 Tahoe Hoall) to officially declare Business Administration as their major for the next semester. (See DPC for deadlines.)
