"Land of the morning calm," tributary state, threat of Japanese invasions, Hangul, yangban, Buddhism, pre-Confucian society & Korean women, Kobukson, Japan's "gunboat diplomacy," 1876 Treat of Kangwha, Horace Allan, King Kojong, David

Deshler, "show money," Christianity among Korean immigrants, Pres. Park Chung Hee's modernization plan, outmigration to Los Angeles, Koreatowns in LA and SF Bay, 1992 Rodney King riots, KAs as "middle-men"
