Filipinos in the Middle East

Qatar, economy, natural gas, oil, diversified economy, per capital incomes, social welfare state (free "everything"), liberal policies, no taxes, Qataris as the "minorities" in their own country, Al Jazeera, absolute monarchy, Emir and Sheikh Al Thani, coup to overthrow father, new Emir in 2013: Tamin Bin Hamad Al Thani
