Qualifications:

- The scholarship is available for students of any major who have demonstrated a commitment and potential for leadership in the Asian American Community.
- Full-time student at time of award and at the time of application.
- Preference for 2.5 GPA or above.
- Required meeting with an Asian American Studies advisor and a community mentor during the academic year of the scholarship.
- Preference may be given to applicants of any major who have taken at least one course in Asian American Studies and/or plan to enroll in at least one Asian American Studies course during the academic year of the scholarship.
- Scholarships awarded to two undergraduate and two graduate students
- Students who received similar scholarships in 2014-2015 are ineligible for a scholarship in 2015-2016.
