Japanese Americans

Japan attacks Pearl Harbor (WW2)

FDR Exec. Order 9066, 110,000 incarcerated in "internment" camps

70,000 Japanese Americans were U.S. born (US citizens)

Leland Ford: put JAs in "concentration camps"

Dr. Seuss cartoon, Ronald Reagan signs "reparation" & formal apology to JAs

Anti-Asian Violence from the Outside

Vincint Chin (27 years old), Highland Park in Detroit, played football (QB) Mistaken for being a Japanese & beaten to death by 2 white men (1982) Assailants never served time in prison: paid a \$3,000 fine + court fees

Filipino immigration to America

Context: Japanese immigration Exclusion. Gentlemen's Agreement (1907-1908)

*Japanese immigrants went to Philippines and "passed" as Filipinos to USA

All Asians were excluded from USA except Filipinos

Hawaiian labor migration: sugar plantations 1906/1946

Albert J. Judd (HSPA recruiter)

Great Depression 1929: low wages & difficult transition

Carlos Bulosan: America is in the Heart

Luzon to Seattle (WA) to Stockton (CA)

Migrant labor life & agriculture

Perfecto delos Santos: born in Aklan Province, arrived in Seattle via SS Madison

Grant, accompanied by Uncle Benny

Stockton = Filipino American "Capital", asparagus industry

Evelyn Nakano-Glenn's "split-family" households

Filipino American history & Global Migration

Manila galleons: polos y servicio

Navigators, soldiers, ship builders

Manila galleon trade = largest economy in the world

FAs = 1st documented Asians to reach the Americas

1587 landing in Moro Bay, California

George Washington: "American Empire"

Admiral Mahan, Influence of Sea Power upon History: Rome & British Empires

"colonies", "naval stations" and "coaling stations" for naval fleet

1898 Spanish-American War: USS Main sinks in Havana, Cuba

Secret Orders to Commodore Dewey in HK

America attacks the Philippines: USS Olympia (modern naval ship)

Racism from America brought to the Philippines ("N" word for Filipinos)

Philippines & USA = height of racism in America

Race as a social construction, "Injuns" and "Savages" and "Niggers" & "goo-goos"

1904 Worlds Fair: Filipinos as "dog eaters" and "savages"

Col. Landsale: CIA agent working for President, HUKS (communists), sent to

Vietnam and then El Salvador

Pre-1965 Immigration: Hawaii, Guam (Camp Roxas), California (Stockton)

Asians in World War II

Chinese & Mexicans were in regular US Army units (not segregated)

Capt. Francis Wai (Chinese-Hawaiian, Medal of Honor), Bjagat Singg Thind

Japanese & Filipinos & African Americans = segregated unites

Hawaiian National Guard = 100 Infantry Battalion

Hawaii + Mainland JAs = 442 Regimental Combat Team

100/442 RCT: two units were joined together in Europe

"Purple Heart Battalion", 21 Medal of Honors + Presidential Unit Citation

1st & 2nd Filipino Infantry Regiments

Dr. Alex Fabros (Col. USArmy, retired)

Pacita Todtod: responsible for letter writing campaign, Filipinos were allowed to join the US Army & serve in the War. Lt. Col. Robert Offley (spoke Tagalog) 1st Filipino Infantry Reg. (Camp Beale), 2nd Filipino Infantry Reg. (Camp Cooke) "Manongs" were mostly from California, Young men from Hawaii Sgt. Leo Giron (15 year old farm worker), BNMA martial arts, commando in WW2 Sgt. Domingo Los Banos (young man from Hawaii), "UnTold Triumph" filmed in Stockton, SF, Elk Grove
