



Call For Refereed Papers **Extended to July 1, 2003**

WFEA Conference in Salt Lake City, UT
October 29-31, 2003

Papers are now being solicited for the Western Family Economics Association (formerly Western Region Home Management-Family Economics Educators) Conference in Salt Lake City, Utah, October 29-31, 2003.

You are invited to submit paper based on research, theory development, history, literature review, position statements, innovative teaching techniques or program development and evaluation. Acceptance will be based on the paper's contribution to the field of family economics or family resource management and the recommendations of a minimum of two reviewers, with the emphasis on quality of the work and technical accuracy. However, no paper can be accepted unless the author or a willing colleague will present it at the conference. Every presenting author is expected to pay full registration fees.

Guidelines and Time Table

July 1, 2003 -- Completed paper to committee chair (postmarked)
July 30, 2003 -- Review completed, decision to authors

Electronic submissions using an email attachment in WORD are preferred. Otherwise, mail four copies of the paper to the address below. The style guidelines in the publication manual of the American Psychological Association (5th Edition) are required. Be sure to include a separate, title page including title, author(s), institution, and lead author's address, e-mail, and telephone number. Also, include an abstract at the beginning of the paper that does not exceed 175 words. The paper should be of a length that could be presented in a 20-minute time frame (i.e., a maximum of 25 double-spaced pages including all tables, bibliographic materials, etc).
