Call for Poster & Curriculum Showcase

2003 Annual Conference in Salt Lake City, UT

October 29-31, 2003

Refereed Submissions: All submissions will be blind-reviewed. Research posters should reflect scholarly pursuits which are suitable for poster format. Curriculum Showcase materials include the sharing of resources and ideas used in teaching. Abstract not exceeding 2 pages may be printed in the *Papers* at the request of the presenter.

Purpose: Presentation of information on completed research, special programs or projects, teaching innovations, curriculum issues, etc. in a format, which can be displayed for review by conference participants. Appropriate subjects include: new course designs, innovative teaching methods, materials used in instruction or extension, basic or applied research, methodological studies, program evaluation, computer programs, course assignments which facilitate application of management/economic concepts, demonstration of mini-lessons used in the classroom or training sessions, or exploration of ideas for peer response.

Presenter Duties:

- stand next to your submission to explain and discuss it during the
- secure your own audiovisual or computer equipment, as needed.
- provide copies of written materials or project abstracts for distribution.

Proposal: 4 copies of Cover Page Form and 4 copies of 2-page description of poster or curriculum showcase content

Cover page form (not counted in 2 page limit) must include: title, author(s) name(s), institutional affiliation, address, telephone number, and type of content to be presented (research or curriculum related)

Description of Poster: Maximum of 2 pages, single-spaced. Must include: Title, Purpose, Method or Description of program, project, course, activity, Results/conclusion/applications, and References

Evaluation Criteria include: Appropriateness to conference theme and to a poster or showcase format;

Criteria: Title is descriptive of poster topic;
Clear description of purpose, methods, or description of program, etc.
Clear presentation of results, conclusions and applications/implications
References support the poster topic;
Planned format of poster display supports purpose of research, project;
Proposal presents a new idea, approach, method

Guidelines and Time Table

June 15, 2003 -- Completed paper to committee chair (postmarked)

July 30, 2003 -- Review completed, decision to authors

Electronic submissions using an email attachment in WORD are preferred. Otherwise, mail four copies of the paper to the address below. The style guidelines in the publication manual of the American Psychological Association (5th Edition) are required. Be sure to include the separate, title page including title, author(s), institution, and lead author's address, e-mail, and telephone number, example below.
