



**Call for Posters and Curriculum Showcase**  
**Western Family Economics Association**  
**2007 Annual Conference in Tucson, AZ**  
**January 24-27, 2007**

**Reviewed Submissions:** All submissions will be blind peer-reviewed. Posters should present completed research or scholarship suitable for poster format. Curriculum showcase exhibits or mini-lessons should present uniquely fitting approaches to educational content, methods or materials to be showcased as an exhibit or mini-lesson. Evaluation criteria include appropriateness to conference theme or family economics field, as well as clarity, accuracy, importance and uniqueness of contribution.

**Purpose:** Presentation of information on completed research, special programs or projects, teaching innovations, curriculum content, issues analysis, etc. in a format that can be displayed or presented to conference participants. Appropriate subjects include: unique approaches to course content, new course designs, innovative teaching methods, materials used in instruction or extension, basic or applied research, methodological studies, program evaluation, computer-based programs, course assignments which facilitate application of learning concepts, demonstration of mini-lessons used in instruction, or exploration of ideas for peer response.

**Presenter Duties:**

- Stand next to your poster or exhibit to explain or discuss it at conference.
- Present or provide overview of your mini-lesson in a 15 minute period.
- Provide copies of included materials or project abstract for distribution.

**Proposal:** 4 copies of both Cover Page Form and 2-page description of poster or showcase. Designate showcase to be presented as either exhibit or mini-lesson. Cover page must include: title, author(s) name(s), institutional affiliation, address, telephone number, and category. Description must include title and description of purpose, rationale, content, method, and references as well as any conclusions or results.

**Guidelines and Time Table**

**September 29, 2006 (Extended to October 6, 2006)** -- Paper submitted electronically to WFEA Conference Program Chair.

**November 6, 2006** -- Review completed and decision sent to authors.

*Electronic submissions using an email attachment in WORD are required.* The style guidelines in the publication manual of the American Psychological Association (5<sup>th</sup> Edition) are required.
