2007 Scholarship Announcement (2nd Update)

The Northern California Chapter of the Association For Intelligence Officers (formerly called the Association of Former Intelligence Officers) announces two (2) scholarship awards for school year 2007. Each scholarship is valued at \$1,500.00.

Applicants for these two scholarships need to demonstrate interest in a future government career in intelligence. US citizenship is a requirement.

Applications should be submitted by 31 December 2006. No applications postmarked after 31 December 2006 will be accepted. Finalists will be invited for interview by the AFIO Scholarship Board in late January for interviews in February 2007. Please note that travel expenses for this interview are the responsibility of the applicant.

The two scholarship winners will be announced by March 15, 2007.

Eligible students must be high school seniors, college freshmen or sophomores from within the territorial boundaries of this AFIO Northern California Chapter.

A transcript including grades for at least the last two years of academic study completed must be submitted.

Applicants are required to submit an essay of no more than two (2) pages describing the applicant's interest in a future career in intelligence or counterintelligence. Applicants should include details of their personal interests, foreign language skills, and extra-curricular activities in this essay.

The AFIO Scholarship Board will select the winners of this competition. Cash awards will be released upon proof of enrollment in fall semester of 2007.

Letters of recommendation (no more than two recommendations) from instructors or school counselors who are aware of the applicant's interest in a career in intelligence, or counterintelligence, may be helpful in the evaluation process. Instructors or school counselors are requested to include a reply address and telephone number if follow-up contact is necessary.

Applications, and accompanied documents (transcript with two years of most recent academic grades, letters of recommendation and the essay describing the applicant's interest in an intelligence or counterintelligence career) should be postmarked no later than December 31, 2006 to the following address:
