#### **Biomes**

• **Biome**: large community of plants and animals in a particular environment

### Tundra

• Cold desert/grassland

#### **Boreal forest**

- Subarctic climate
- Extensive area, but simple community

#### Midlatitude deciduous forest

- Moderate precipitation, varying temperatures
- Dense, broadleaf, deciduous trees

## Midlatitude grassland

- Steppe climate
- Prairie, steppe, veldt, pampas

#### Mediterranean woodland/shrub

- Matches mediterranean climate
- Open, grassy woodland, or chaparral

#### Desert

- Covers 1/3 of Earth's land area
- Preserving moisture and avoiding heat

## Tropical savanna

• Savanna or desert climates

### Tropical scrub

- Savanna or steppe climates
- Low-growing, scraggly trees and bushes, many with thorns

### Tropical deciduous forest

- Dry period of weeks or months
- Deciduous trees (moisture, not light), shrubs

### Tropical rainforest

- Consistent rainfall, high temperatures
- Most complex ecosystem
