This course consists of a series of thirteen talks presented by invited speakers. The talks will cover a broad range of topics but, in general, focus on solutions to biological problems utilizing cell and molecular techniques.

Grading: CR/NC only. You will receive credit if you miss no more than two talks. You may still receive credit if you miss three talks if you submit a summary of one additional talk (minimum of two pages, typed, double-spaced). Attendance will be recorded using a sign-up sheet that will be passed around during each talk. It is your responsibility to sign it before leaving class. Inappropriate conduct will also result in a NC.

Conduct: Seminar speakers provide a great service, usually without compensation. In return, it is our responsibility to listen attentively and not disrupt the presentation. Listening attentively does not include resting or sleeping. To avoid disrupting a presentation, please observe the following guidelines: arrive on time and do not leave early (if this is not possible, then sit near the least conspicuous exit and close the door quietly. Electronic devices should be off (or set to vibrate, if necessary). Failure to be respectful of a speaker in any way, including those listed above, will result in being dropped from the course or receiving a NC grade. At the end of a presentation, it is appropriate to ask questions. You are encouraged to ask questions at this time.
