Contents (outline)

By Week 3, each student submits his or her individual reading project plan (読み物プロジェクトプラン).

From Week 4, each student begins reading a literature of their choice (at least 30 minutes a day for reading outside of class time) and writes a journal entry about their progress (e.g. newly learned words/expressions, kanji, and content).

Then, the instructor has 3 individual consultations and each consultation lasts 10 minutes. The consultation is held during Week 5~6, Week 8~9, Week 13~14 (before their final presentation). Students are expected to follow a certain format to report their progress (see . 第一回、二回、三回プロジェクトコンサルテーションガイドライン). During these three face-to-face consultations, an instructor guides students to:

- retell and describe the story
- summarize what they read in Japanese
- express and explain important points / theme(s) in Japanese
- state his or her opinions on reading material
- rehearse his or her presentation by offering advice

After the first consultation, each student makes a presentation on what he or she is reading.

On Week $13 \sim 15$, each student makes a presentation in the format of classroom presentation or a poster session. Students who prepare their presentations early (Week 13 and 14) present their reading project in class. The rest conduct a poster session for a small audience by preparing a poster board for his or her presentation. Each student is also required to attend all poster sessions and write a brief report on each presentation. Then, each student submits his or her presentation report (script & essay).

Note: I reserved 5 seminar rooms for 2 days (2 hours x 2 = 4 hours). On Day 1, I assigned one student to each room (the total of five students). These five students were required to repeat their presentation 5 times in his or her seminar room. The audience (25 students) was required to listen to all five poster-sessions and write a brief report on each presentation. I asked one helper to keep track of the time (10 minutes), and when the time was up, the audience moved to a different seminar room. Then, the next five students went to each of their assigned room, and repeated their poster session five times. On Day 2, I repeated the same process. All poster sessions were successfully completed. Due to the small number of students in the audience and the fact that the presenters have to repeat their presentation five times, they were overall satisfied with their performance.
