  - o In-class lessons review the material covered in online video lectures and demonstrate how to solve practice quiz problems. Students are encouraged to ask questions and discuss the course material during these in-class lessons. I also post my hand-written solutions to practice quiz questions and problems that are demonstrated in class.
