You are enrolled in my Distance Ed course STAT 1, Section 11 or Section 12. In order to continue being enrolled in this course, you MUST fulfill the Intermediate Algebra Diagnostic test (IAD) by Friday, Feb 1. You can do this in the following ways:

- 1. Register and take IAD test and show a passing score, or
- 2. Show a passing IAD score dated May 2012 or later, or
- 3. Show unofficial transcript indicating that you took and passed Math 24 or Math 26A or Math 29 or Math 30 here at Sac State, or
- 4. Show records indicating that you took Calculus 1 or above (NOT math 24 Or Math 26A etc.) here or in another institution.

These are the only four acceptable options. If you do not personally show me the IAD completion by one of the above options, you will be dropped from the course and your spot will go to someone who has completed the IAD requirement. IAD test is given on Wed Jan 23, Mon Jan 28 to Fri Feb 1 in BRH-118. For registering, preparing and taking IAD as soon as possible go to
