1. How your individual presentation was graded:

Your presentation was graded by using the rubric, which was included in the “Guidelines for Written Report (Part III)” handout, page 10.

Score was calculated as follows—

Evaluation Criteria: During your presentation, each group was scored on each of the criteria (indicated under “Evaluation”) on a scale of 0 to 5, with 0=missing; 1=weak; 2=poor; 3=acceptable; 4=good; and 5=excellent. The scores were added and divided by 13, unless there were no questions/feedback from the audience, in which case the score was divided by 12. The resulting average was multiplied by 20, to arrive at a numeric grade for your presentation. A perfect score would be 100.

As was indicated on the guidelines, you were also given 1 point each for 1) meeting time requirement (20-25 minutes) and 2) Providing presentation handout at least 2 days prior to the actual presentation.

If you would like to discuss your grade for the presentation, please do so when we come back from Thanksgiving. I won’t be checking my e-mails as regularly as I would during the holidays, and will not discuss your grade over e-mail. You may come in during my office hours or set up an appointment with me regarding the grade.
